Mold Library and [Flintshire Connects](#) offer complimentary services to customers.

Mold Library has a busy lending section on the ground floor offering a wide range of materials for loan including DVDs and audio books on CD. There are computers available for use free of charge, one of which is in the children's library. Other facilities include a scanner, a colour photocopier, fax and theatre booking services.

A Payment Kiosk enabling customers to pay rent, rates and invoices owing to Flintshire County Council is situated on the ground floor and a Tourist Information Point displaying leaflets for local attractions.

The @nswers centre on the first floor provides a reference and information service and a collection of local and family history resources. There is space to do research and there are further computers and a scanner.

The Mold Museum is also on the first floor with displays showing the development of Mold as a market town and two rooms re-creating Victorian novelist Daniel Owen's study and tailor's shop.

Mold Library and Museum is in the town centre opposite the Post Office on Earl Road. The nearest car park is in Meadow Place. There are larger, long stay car parks in New Street and Love Lane.

The library has automatic doors and a lift to the first floor where the customer toilets are located.
