

## Notice of Making

### THE FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

### LINDEN AVENUE, BEECHWOOD AVENUE AND ST DAVID'S DRIVE, CONNAH'S QUAY

#### PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME AND NO STOPPING

Notice is hereby given that on the 16<sup>th</sup> February 2022, Flintshire County Council made an Order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004, Part IV of Schedule 9 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to amend The Flintshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2013 so as to introduce:

1. 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions:-

- a. On both sides of Linden Avenue in the vicinity of Ysgol Bryn Deva, Connaah's Quay
- b. On both sides of St David's Drive in the vicinity of property number 1 and 10, Connaah's Quay
- c. At the junction of Beechwood Avenue with Linden Ave, Connaah's Quay
- d. At the junction of St David's Drive with Linden Avenue, Connaah's Quay


2. No Stopping on School Keep Clear Markings. Monday – Friday 8.00am – 5.00pm

- a. On the North Easterly side of Linden Avenue, adjacent to Ysgol Bryn Deva, Connaah's Quay.
- b. On the North Westerly side of St David's Drive, adjacent to Ysgol Bryn Deva, Connaah's Quay.

In all other respects the present provisions of the 'The Flintshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2013' will remain in force.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instruments made under it has not been complied with, you may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
