(ONE WAY TRAFFIC) ORDER 202x

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

A successful bid was made to the Welsh Government and as such Flintshire County Council have been successful in obtaining funding to implement substantial safety measures to address congestion and reduce unnecessary vehicle movements experienced along the routes to Ysgol Croes Atti and Ysgol Ty Fynnon.

Many of the problems identified along the route relate to high levels of vehicle usage and associated congestion both within the immediate curtilage of the school as well as along a number of access routes in the vicinity.

Within recent years, Flintshire County Council have received a number of concerns from residents, Pupils, Parents, Teaching staff and Local Members due to concerns of both increasing levels of congestion and speed of traffic in the vicinity of the school.

In light of the above, it is proposed to extend the existing One Way system on King George Street from the access to Charmleys Lane Car Park to the junction with Mostyn Street.

The existing One Way streets on Plymouth Street, King George Street, Mostyn Street and Rowden Street will remain and will allow cyclists to proceed in the length of roads in a direction where vehicles are prohibited.

The County Council continues its responsibility to consider the provision of convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measure is aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised whilst facilitating the effective and safe passage of traffic.

The proposals are detailed in the Public Notice and are contained in the proposed Draft Order.
