

Flintshire County Summer Playscheme Programme

Flintshire County Council Summer Play team will be providing free 'open access' play sessions for children aged 5 -12 years in your community. 'Open access' means that all children are welcome and free to join in as many sessions as they are able, throughout the Summer. Children will have the freedom and flexibility to 'come and go' as they please. Your child's safety is of paramount importance. Therefore, please give clear instructions with regard to his/her attending the scheme. It must be understood that if he/she insists on leaving the site early, they do so with your approval. Alternatively, if a parent or carer (Adult) wishes to remain on site then that is perfectly acceptable.

Play will be 'child-led' with children choosing what and how they play. The session will be staffed by trained playworkers, who will facilitate children's play and have a wide variety of ideas and equipment. Full use will be made of the natural elements and the environment.

The scheme is not for children under five years of age. This age group requires special provision and attention, which we are not able to provide. However, it is acceptable, if a parent or carer (Adult) remains on site and takes personal responsibility, whilst he/she is in attendance

- Water/messy play
- Arts and crafts
