20mph Online Household Survey

Summary


The purpose of the questionnaire was to invite feedback from households located on roads and streets where 20mph speed restrictions had been introduced to learn more about its impact.

9,426 households, received an invitation by post to take part online, or where support was needed by visiting the Connects Centre in Buckley.

Open between Thursday 24 November 2022 and Sunday 18 December 2022 a total of 2,712 households completed the questionnaire and a summary of the findings can be found below.

Your Road/Street

The first part of the questionnaire was aimed at understanding what people thought about the introduction of 20mph restrictions on the road/street where they lived.




Do you support the introduction of a 20mph speed limit in your road/street?

A total of 2,699 households responded to this question with 1,083 indicating they were supportive of its introduction on their road/street.


Those who responded 'yes' were then asked:

Those who responded 'no' were asked



The second part of the questionnaire was aimed at understanding what households felt about the introduction of 20mph restrictions on other roads/streets (not the road/street on which they lived).


Do you support the introduction of 20mph speed limits in other roads/streets in Buckley and areas surrounding it?




A total of 2685 households responded to this question with 474 indicating they were supportive of its introduction on roads/streets other than where they lived.
