

**Notice of Temporary Prohibition of Pedestrians Order**  
**Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 - Section 14**  
**Public Footpath No. 40a in the Community of Brynford**

Flintshire County Council has made an Order which will prohibit pedestrians from using a section of Public Footpath No. 40a in the Community of Brynford from a point at the western end near the Kennels at NGR 31594 37492 to a point at the eastern part of the Byway at its junction with Public Footpath No. 41 at NGR 31656 37498.

The reason for closure is to protect the public for Health and Safety reasons due to the dangerous condition vehicles have left the Byway in.

It is anticipated that the Order will come into force on the 5<sup>th</sup> April 2021, or as soon as possible thereafter. The footpath closure is expected to last for a maximum period of six months.
