

How to get your NHS COVID Pass

The NHS COVID Pass lets you share your COVID vaccination records in a secure way.

It allows you to prove you've been vaccinated, or that you've had a negative lateral flow test. This could be to:

- Travel abroad.
- Attend large events, nightclubs, theatres, cinemas and concert halls if you're over 18.

Where can I get my NHS COVID pass?

The NHS Covid Pass is available digitally and can be downloaded to your phone, tablet or computer.

Where can I get my proof of a negative lateral flow test (LFT)?

If you're not fully vaccinated, you'll need to prove you've had a negative lateral flow test in the last 48 hours before you can enter large events, nightclubs, theatres, cinemas and concert halls.

You can order lateral flow test kits from www.gov.wales/rapidtesting, **collect from your pharmacy** or by calling **119**.

You must report your result within 24 hours here www.gov.uk/report-covid19-result
You can show either your text/email with your test result, or it will appear on your NHS COVID Pass as proof to enter.



How do I get a digital NHS COVID pass? Here is a step-by-step guide.

Step 1

Visit
www.gov.wales/nhscovidpass

Step 2

You'll need to log in or register for an NHS account. You'll be asked for your NHS number, but don't worry if you don't have it.

Step 3

You may be asked to do some security checks to prove your identity, this includes a photo of your ID and recording a short video of yourself.

Step 4

Once processed, your NHS COVID Pass will appear on screen and you can download it onto your phone, table or computer. You can also print a copy of it.

The NHS Covid Pass is valid for 30 days before you need to renew it. This is to keep it secure.

It uses your NHS account information to prove your vaccination status and test results.
