The Coal Authority is a non-departmental public body sponsored by the Department of Business, Energy & Industrial Strategy. As a statutory consultee, The Coal Authority has a duty to respond to planning applications and development plans in order to protect the public and the environment in mining areas.

Our records indicate that within the Flintshire area there are recorded coal mining features present at surface and surface depth including; mine entries, shallow coal workings and reported surface hazards. These features pose a potential risk to surface stability and public safety.
