Cadole is a very small village within the Clwydian Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty on the county boundary with Denbighshire. The village is very well related to Gwernymynydd and will benefit from the services therein. Cadole itself has very few facilities (a shop (closed June 2015) and a pub). Beyond Cadole within Denbighshire on the Ruthin road there is a pub at loggerheads and a Texaco petrol filling station with convenience shop and Automatic Teller Machine.

Broadband Provision

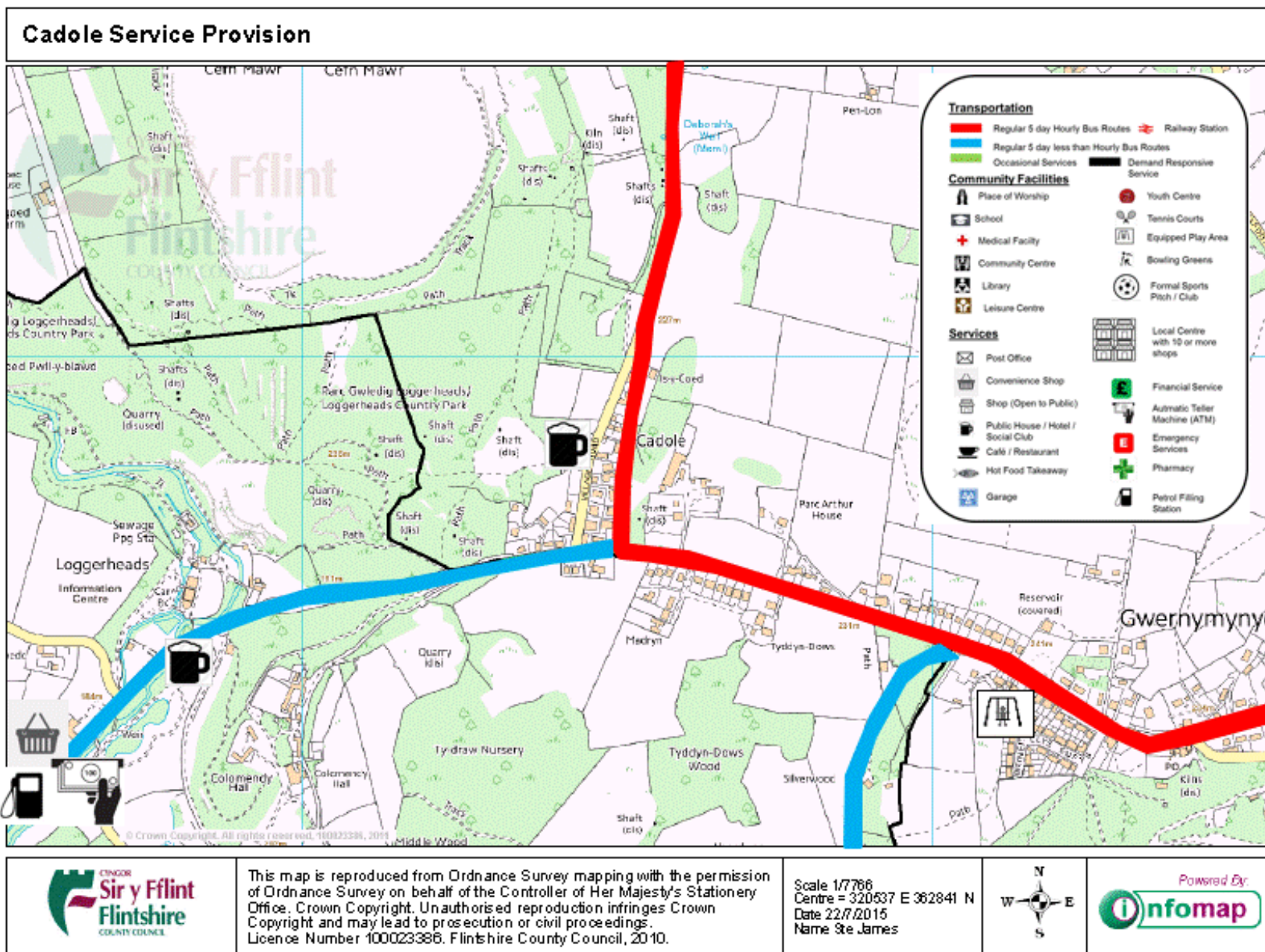
According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Cadole post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 5.1 mega bytes per second.
