

DRURY & BURNTWOOD - SETTLEMENT SERVICE AUDIT

Settlement Commentary

Burntwood and Drury sit to the north east of Buckley. The village is semi-urban in character and its built form is relatively easily defined on plan. The conjoined villages of Burntwood and Drury benefit from a good level of service provision and is conveniently located to access services and employment opportunities in neighbouring Buckley, Ewloe and Broughton.

Broadband Provision

According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Burntwood and Drury post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 2.4 – 9.5 mega bytes per second with most postcodes at 6mbps. Accordingly it is to be expected that broadband provision in Burntwood and Drury is poor and is constrained. This will have a negative effect on businesses in their day to day operation and on local

residents seeking to access online services such as banking, post office services or online shopping.

Other Comments

Buckley, Ewloe and Broughton are very close by and offer additional services and facilities.

Previous Surveys of Service Provision

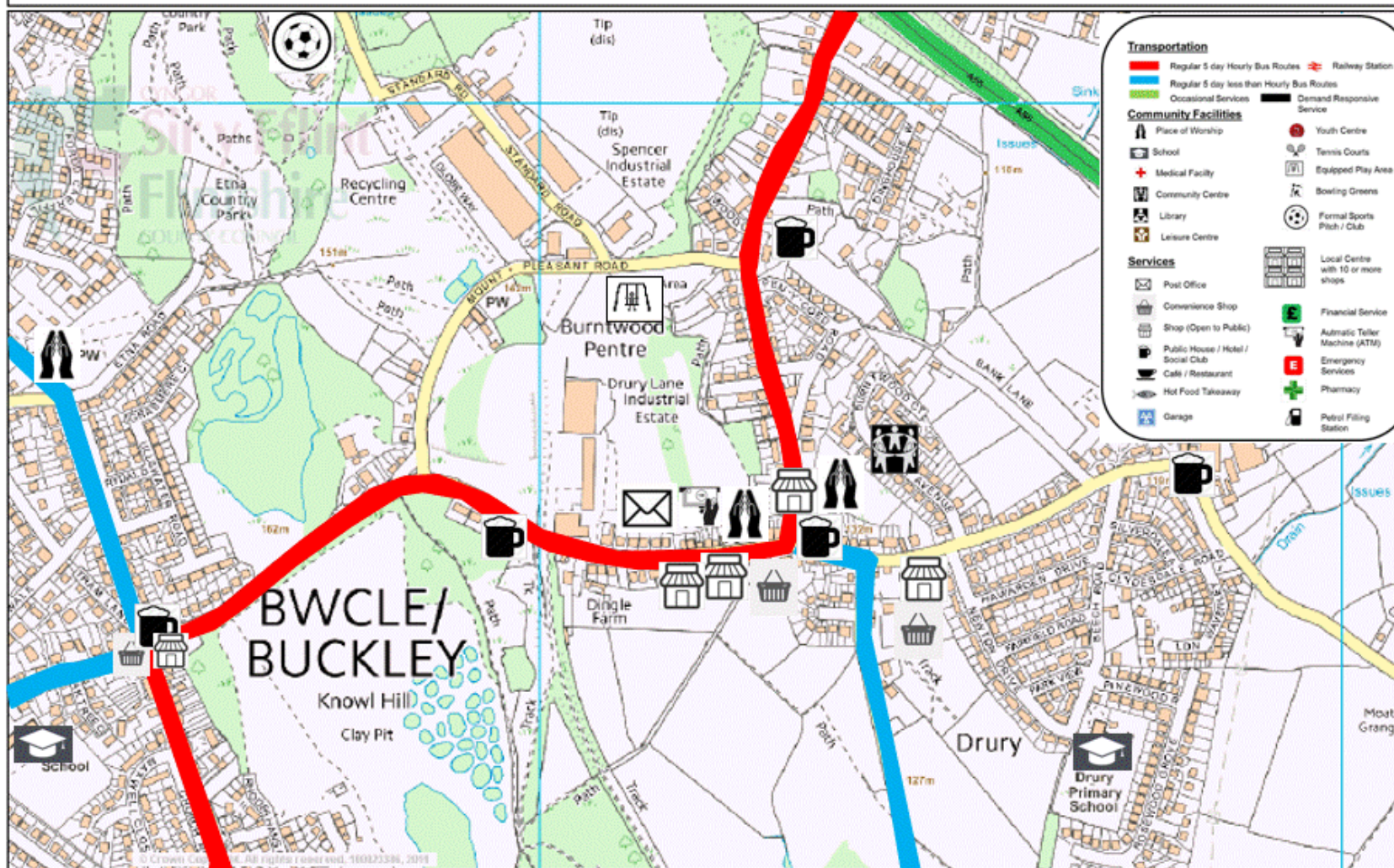
Comparison of previous surveys with 2015 findings indicate that service provision has not changed significantly in the settlement.

Mapping Service Provision

Burntwood and Drury have a good level of service provision given the size of the settlement and benefits from being close to Buckley, Ewloe and Broughton. As the illustrative map of service provision suggests service provision in Burntwood and Drury is very good but the close proximity of Buckley, Ewloe and Broughton further improve service provision to the benefit of local residents.
