

## NANNERCH - SETTLEMENT SERVICE AUDIT

### Settlement Commentary

Nannerch is a small and attractive settlement located immediately to the south of the A541 Mold – Denbigh Road. The village is relatively compact with a historic central core which is designated as a Conservation Area. The village is situated some distance away from any major settlements (Holywell 5 miles, Mold 7 miles) being located in a relatively isolated part of the County in an area of undeveloped countryside and high landscape value within the Clwydian Range Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.

**Broadband Provision**

According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Nannerch post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 2.3-4.8 megabytes per second. Accordingly it is to be expected that broadband provision in Nannerch is poor and is constrained. This is likely to have a negative effect on the ability of local residents operating a business in Nannerch or seeking to access online services such as banking, post office services or online shopping. Anecdotal evidence suggests that although broadband is stronger in the village itself, it is poor on the outskirts.
