Tre Mostyn is a small rural hamlet located to the West of Rhewl and Maes Pennant. The settlement contains no services and is served by a demand response public transport service which must be booked in advance. Access to and from Tre Mostyn is limited and local residents are completely reliant upon day to day and weekly services and facilities outside of Tre Mostyn in Maes Pennant and Holywell.

According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Rhewl Mostyn post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 3.6-7.8 mega-bytes per second. 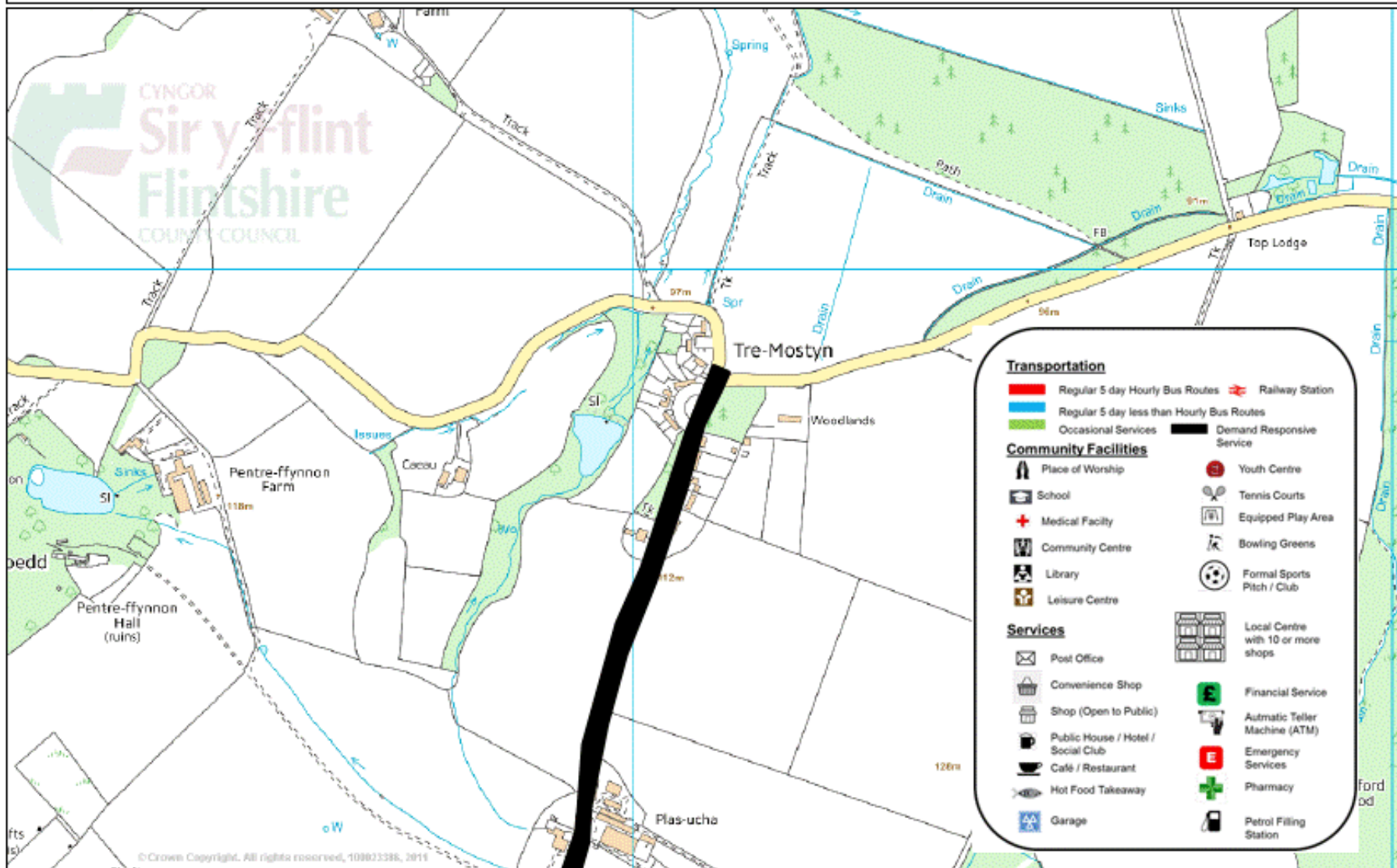
## Previous Surveys of Service Provision
