

TRELOGAN & BETHENGAM - SETTLEMENT SERVICE AUDIT

Settlement Commentary

Trelogan and Berthengam is a small rural settlement within the rural North West of the County. The village has a ribbon built form which stretches for approximately half a mile. The settlement has a primary School, Ysgol Trelogan, but few other services and facilities and is served by a bus service which is less than hourly in frequency. The day to day needs of residents are unlikely to be met within the village, for example there is no convenience shop. It is expected that residents will travel to nearby settlements such as Trelawnyd (Post Office), or to larger towns such as Holywell and Prestatyn for weekly convenience shopping and banking.

Bus service frequency	Yes, Service no. 19 provides 5 buses a day from Trelogan and Berthengam to Rhyl between the times of 0812 and 1537. From Rhyl back to the village there are 6 buses during the day between 0809 and 1739.
Cycle route	Yes, an on road route runs along the south of the village, which connects to Llanasa to the west and Whitford to the east.
Access to main highway network	Yes, Access can be gained to the A5151 to the south and the A548 to the north.

Broadband Provision

According to the latest OFCOM data (2013) Trelogan and Berthengam post codes (where data is available) have a median average broadband range of 1.5-2.6 megabytes per second. This is a very poor level of broadband provision and it is likely that many residents will struggle to gain broadband access here. This very poor level of broadband provision will adversely impact the ability of local residents

and businesses alike whether in day to day business activities or for accessing online services such as banking, post office services or online shopping.

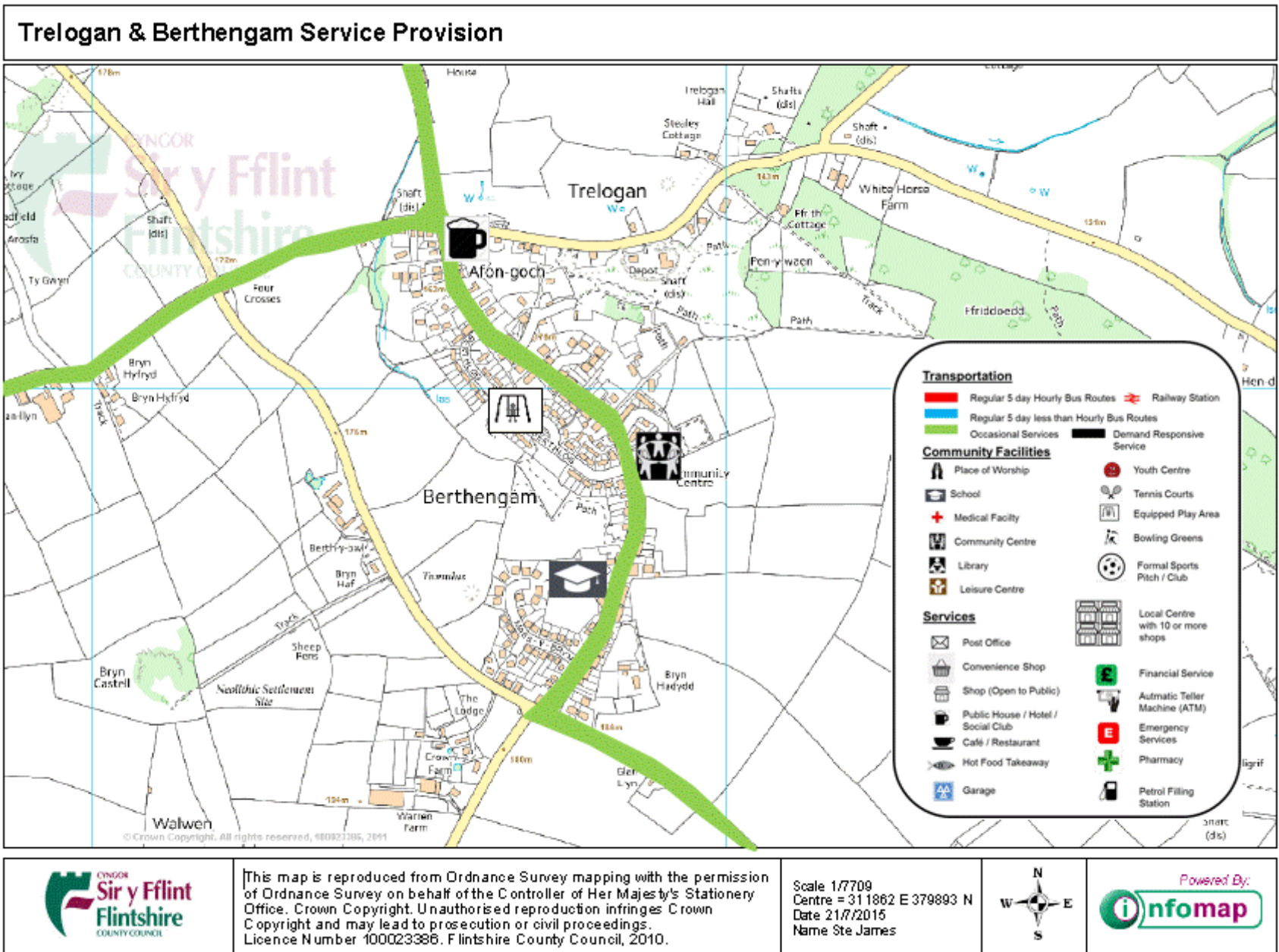
Previous Surveys of Service Provision
