Important changes to the CT6 Service

Following a review of the existing service and the low passenger numbers, the service is to be changed with the removal of the CT6 service from the 29th of February 2020.

Passengers in the Cymau, Ffrith, Llanfynydd and Treuddyn areas are able to use the LT7 service to Hope to connect with the LT8 service which will take them to Broughton via Penyffordd and Higher Kinnerton. (timetable attached).

OUTBOUND journeys to Broughton connect at 10:52 and 13:02.

INBOUND journeys from Broughton connect at 13:04 and 17:04.

Those passengers that currently use the CT6 can take advantage of the Flintshire County Council Demand Responsive Transport service (D.R.T) to book a journey on Tuesday the 3rd, 10th, 17th, 24th and 31st of March following the 9:50 am timetable (to return on the 12:30 timetable).

Bookings can be made on the phone number enclosed in the leaflet provided, annual registration fee will not apply for this period. During this time we will review the changes before implementing a more permanent arrangement at the end of March 2020.
