Notice is hereby given that on the 19<sup>th</sup> September 2023, Flintshire County Council made an Order in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all enabling powers, the effect of which will be:-

- a) To impose a speed limit of 20mph on the length of roads specified in the Schedule to this notice.

**STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE ORDER**

The Welsh Government will introduce a national default 20mph speed limit on all restricted roads within Wales from 17<sup>th</sup> September 2023.


Restricted roads are usually located in residential and built-up areas and have a system of street lighting.

The Authority are reviewing all speed limits within the County, in relation to their suitability to the legislation and the roads within the above list form part of this.


Due to the length of roads contained within this proposed Traffic Regulation Order being in a peripheral area that has no street lighting present for the full extents. Therefore, a 20mph Traffic Regulation Order is proposed, as these roads support the criteria for the suggested advertised speed limit

The Authority continues its responsibility to consider the provision of the convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measures are aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised to road users as well as improving the amenities of the locality.


