

NOTICE OF MAKING

THE FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN FLINTSHIRE) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2023

Notice is hereby given that on the 19th September 2023, Flintshire County Council made an Order in exercise of its powers under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all enabling powers, the effect of which will be:-

- a) To impose a speed limit of 30mph on the roads as specified in the Schedules to this notice.

SCHEDULE 1 **30MPH Speed Limit** **MOLD**

A541 DENBIGH ROAD, MOLD: from a point 17 metres north west of the junction of Factory Pool Lane with the A541 for a distance of 335 metres in a south easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 2 **30MPH Speed Limit** **CONNAHS QUAY**

B5129 KELSTERTON ROAD: from the junction with the A548 roundabout, for a distance of 410 metres in an easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 3 **30MPH Speed Limit** **GREENFIELD**

B5121 GREENFIELD ROAD, GREENFIELD: from a point 18 metres north east of the junction of Level Mine Road with the B5121 for a distance of 770 metres in a north easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 4 **30MPH Speed Limit** **EWLOE**

ST DAVIDS PARK: from a point 125 metres north east of the junction of Sheridan Avenue for a distance of 592 metres, to the junction with the B5125.

A5026 HOLWAY ROAD, HOLYWELL: from a point 680 metres north west of its junction with Saith Aelwyd Park to a point 52 metres north west of its junction with Carmel Road.

SCHEDULE 6

BROUGHTON

A5104 MOLD ROAD AND A55 WARREN INTERCHANGE: A5104 Mold Road Broughton, from a point 150 metres south west of its junction with the A55 (measured from the centre of the southerly roundabout, to a point 75 metres west of its junction with the Old Warren.

LESTERS LANE, BROUGHTON : From a point 175 metres from its junction with the A5104 for a distance of 72 metres in a southerly direction

B5129 CHESTER ROAD WEST: From its junction with the Queensferry Interchange Roundabout, for a distance of 32 metres in a northerly direction.

B5129 CHESTER ROAD EAST: From its junction with the Queensferry Interchange Roundabout, for a distance of 197 metres in an easterly direction. Including the Queensferry interchange roundabout.

BUCKLEY

B5127 LIVERPOOL ROAD: from a point 37 metres north of its junction with Rhuddlan Road, to a point 238 metres west of its junction with Old Liverpool Road.

A549 CHESTER ROAD, BUCKLEY: from a point 32 metres east of its junction with Forest Walk to a point 80 metres east of Little Mountain Road.

B5128 CHURCH ROAD: from its junction with the A549, for a distance of 300 metres in a northerly direction.

DRURY LANE: from a point 62 metres from its junction with Lon Treftadaeth, to a point 47 metres west of Drury Lane Industrial Estate junction.



**THE FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

(30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2023**

The Flintshire County Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 82 (2) (a), 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1984") and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:

1. In this Order except where otherwise stated any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the length of roads specified in the Schedules to this Order.
3. The roads specified in Schedule 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 & 9 to this Notice, shall cease to be a Restricted Road for the purposes of Section 81 of this Act
4. The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the 19th September 2023 and may be cited as The Flintshire County Council (VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN FLINTSHIRE) (30 mph Speed Limit) Order 2023.

A541 DENBIGH ROAD: from a point 17 metres north west of the junction of Factory Pool Lane with the A541 for a distance of 335 metres in a south easterly direction.

**SCHEDULE 2

B5129 KELSTERTON ROAD: from the junction with the A548 roundabout, for a distance of 410 metres in an easterly direction.

SCHEDULE 3

STATEMENT OF REASONS FOR PROPOSING TO MAKE THE ORDER

The Welsh Government will introduce a national default 20mph speed limit on all restricted roads within Wales from 17th September 2023.

Restricted roads are usually located in residential and built-up areas and have a system of street lighting.

Welsh government have advised that reducing the speed limit from 30mph to 20mph on restricted roads could see many benefits. The advantages to a reduction in speed limit include;

- Improving safety around schools and other locations with high pedestrian traffic
- Improving safety for pedestrians and cyclists
- Discouraging ‘rat running’ through residential streets
- Improve accessibility by reducing motor vehicle dominance along the highway

‘Place’ criteria have been developed to determine where 20mph speed limits should be applied, providing a consistent approach across Wales.

Not all restricted roads that currently have a 30mph limit will be suitable to change to 20mph. In November 2022 Welsh Government introduced an 'exceptions criteria'. The purpose of this was to provide local councils with some flexibility to retain 30mph speed limits, where appropriate, on some restricted roads. These are termed as ‘exceptions’ to the default speed limit for restricted roads and Legal Orders are prepared to retain the current speed limit for these roads. All speed limits are assessed impartially and in accordance with specified national criteria.

To apply an ‘exception’ to a restricted road, local councils must have a clear and reasoned case for doing so, which demonstrates that strong evidence exists that retaining a higher speed limit would be safe.

Following an assessment of local roads, and working closely with County Councillors, a number of roads in Flintshire have been identified as possible exceptions which have been made available for public inspection on DataMap Wales.

The sections of road below are currently 30mph by restricted road status. The Authority considers that the existing 30 mph is an appropriate speed limit at these locations and as such do not meet the criteria or the nature of a road for a 20mph speed limit.



The sections of road below are already subject to a 20mph speed limit which was implemented in 2022, as part of a first phase of implementation of a change in default speed limit to 20mph within Buckley and the surrounding areas. The Authority does not consider that the existing 20mph speed limit is an appropriate speed limit at these locations and as such do not meet the criteria or the nature of a road for a 20mph speed limit.


