PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME AND NO STOPPING

Notice is hereby given that on the 16th February 2022, Flintshire County Council made an Order in exercise of its powers under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the Traffic Management Act 2004, Part IV of Schedule 9 and all other enabling powers, the effect of which will be to amend The Flintshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2013 so as to introduce:

1. 'No Waiting At Any Time' restrictions:-

- a. On both sides of Linden Avenue in the vicinity of Ysgol Bryn Deva, Connaah's Quay
- b. On both sides of St David's Drive in the vicinity of property number 1 and 10, Connaah's Quay
- c. At the junction of Beechwood Avenue with Linden Ave, Connaah's Quay
- d. At the junction of St David's Drive with Linden Avenue, Connaah's Quay

2. No Stopping on School Keep Clear Markings. Monday – Friday 8.00am – 5.00pm

- a. On the North Easterly side of Linden Avenue, adjacent to Ysgol Bryn Deva, Connaah's Quay.
- b. On the North Westerly side of St David's Drive, adjacent to Ysgol Bryn Deva, Connaah's Quay.

In all other respects the present provisions of the 'The Flintshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2013' will remain in force.

In the interests of safety during the COVID-19 Pandemic, should you wish to view a copy of this Notice, the Order which will come into operation on the 28th February 2022, plans showing the roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for the making of the Order it is advisable that you view them on our website at www.Flintshire.gov.uk > Resident > Roads, Streets and Travel > Traffic Regulation Orders or you can request a copy of the documents by emailing Streetscene@flintshire.gov.uk or calling 01352701234.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or any of its provisions on the grounds that any requirements of the Act or any instruments made under it has not been complied with, you may, within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.

Flintshire County Council in exercise of its powers under sections 1 (1), 2 (1)(2), 4 (2)(3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act of 1984") as amended, the Traffic Management Act 2004 ("the 2004 Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act of 1984, hereby makes the following Order:-

SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY

Citation and commencement

1. This Order shall come into operation on the 28th February 2022 and may be cited as The Flintshire County Council LINDEN AVENUE, BEECHWOOD AVENUE AND ST DAVID'S DRIVE, CONNAH'S QUAY (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) (Amendment No. 47) Order 2022
2. With effect from the date set out in Article 1 above, Map Schedule AU72 Sheet Revision No: 2 replaces Map Schedule AU72 Sheet Revision 1 and all other map schedules together with the before mentioned map schedules and plans referred to in the Schedules to this Order are incorporated into The Flintshire County Council (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Loading and Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement and Consolidation) Order 2013.
3. The interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation on this Order as it applies for the interpretation of an Act of Parliament
4. In this Order, except where otherwise stated, any reference to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number and any reference to a plan is reference to a plan incorporated in to this order.

PROPOSED PROHIBITION OF WAITING AT ANY TIME AND NO STOPPING

Statement of Reasons for proposing to make the Order

The Introduction of proposed Prohibition of Waiting At Any Time and No Stopping, will improve safety for pedestrians and all road users through the removal of parked vehicles at key locations, whilst also improving traffic flow around Ysgol Bryn Deva. It will also ensure access is maintained for residents, prevent obstruction, maintain visibility at the junctions and also ensure that the junctions are not obstructed by parked vehicles.

Parking at junctions, regardless of the presence of yellow lines, is an offence and the restrictions provide a visual deterrent to reinforce this message. At present, should vehicles be parked within 10 metres of a junction, an act of criminality may be committed and would therefore be subject to enforcement action by North Wales Police. Furthermore the Highway Code states that vehicles should not park near or on a junction as they may cause obstruction and compromise safety for all road users.

The Authorities primary concern is for the safety and wellbeing of the general public, including Children going to and from School. By providing a safe environment for pedestrians, this reduces the risk of accidents occurring between vulnerable users and motor vehicles and will facilitate the uptake of Active modes of Travel for pupils attending Schools within the area.

The County Council continues its responsibility to consider the provision of convenient and safe movement of motor vehicles and other traffic, and the proposed measures are aimed at ensuring that danger is minimised to vulnerable road users aswell as improving the amenities of the locality.

The proposals are detailed in the Public Notice and in the proposed Order




