



**STATUTORY NOTICE TO INCREASE THE CAPACITY AT  
DRURY PRIMARY SCHOOL, BEECH TREE ROAD, DRURY,  
BUCKLEY, FLINTSHIRE, CH7 3EG**

**FLINTSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL**

Notice is given in accordance with section 42 of the School Standards and Organisation Act 2013 and the School Organisation Code that Flintshire County Council of Ty Dewi Sant, St Davids Park, Ewloe, Flintshire, CH5 3FF (“the Local Authority”), having consulted such persons as required, proposes to alter Drury Primary School, Beech Tree Road, Drury, Buckley, Flintshire, CH7 3EG, to

- **Increase the capacity of Drury Primary School from its current provision of 124 full time school places to 180 full time school places, an overall increase of 56 full time places from 1 September 2024.**

Drury primary School is an English medium community primary school currently maintained by Flintshire County Council.

The Local Authority undertook a period of consultation before deciding to publish this proposal. It is proposed to implement the proposal on 1 September 2024.

The current number of full time pupils (age 4 – 11) at the school is 146. The Local Authority proposes to increase the capacity of Drury Primary school from its current provision of 124 full time school places to 180 full time school places, an overall increase of 56 full time places from 1 September 2024.

The increase in capacity would be delivered through extending the existing school building by two classrooms and remodelling the school. It is proposed that the implementation of the new school capacity would be put in place after the building works are completed by 1 September 2024.

The proposal would result in the school’s admission number for ages 4 – 11 increasing from 17 pupils per year group to 25 pupils per year group. There will be 12 Nursery Places.

Admission arrangements will be dealt with in line with the LA's Admission Policy. No provision will be made for either selection by aptitude or pupil banding.

Transport of pupils shall be dealt with by reference to the LA's Home to School Transport Policy.

Within a period of 28 days of the date on which the proposal was published, that is to say by **27<sup>th</sup> October 2022** any person may object to the proposal.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE:**

This note does not form part of the statutory notice, but is intended to explain its general purpose

1. Flintshire County Council acting as the Local Education Authority intends to increase the capacity of Drury Primary School, Drury from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024.
2. This will mean providing an extension and remodelling the existing school to be ready from that date.
3. Arrangements will be made to provide continuity of provision at the school for pupils during the construction works.
4. The school will have an increased capacity from its current provision of 124 full time school places to 180 full time school places, an overall increase of 56 full time places from 1<sup>st</sup> September 2024. There will be 12 nursery places. This increase in capacity will accommodate the increasing demand for places at the school form within the area.
5. Transport and Admissions arrangements will be in accordance with the prevailing Flintshire County Council policies.
