Flintshire has a rich and diverse history including ancient Roman occupation to the vast industrial past which is scattered across the county landscape.

The local area has seen an ever-developing landscape morph over the course of history, with each new development leaving a fresh mark on the pages of Flintshire's archives.

Flintshire hosts a wide variety of historical interests, from medieval castles left to the annals of time, mining sites and factories which arose out of the Industrial Revolution to the spots of culture and institutions of higher knowledge which have developed in the county.

The numerous locations will inform, educate and entertain even the most knowledgeable of historians.

The towns of Buckley, Mold, Flint, Connah's Quay and Holywell also host town heritage trails, which allow you to follow in the footsteps of the historical figures before you and uncover some of the important historical sites and scenes which have played out in the local area.

These trails and more can be located on the North East Wales Digital Trails App - found on the Apple and Google Play stores – which gives you a path map along with a range of multimedia information about the trail.

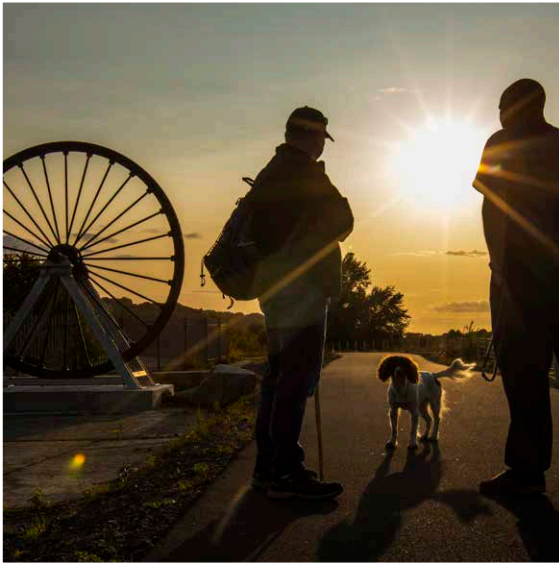

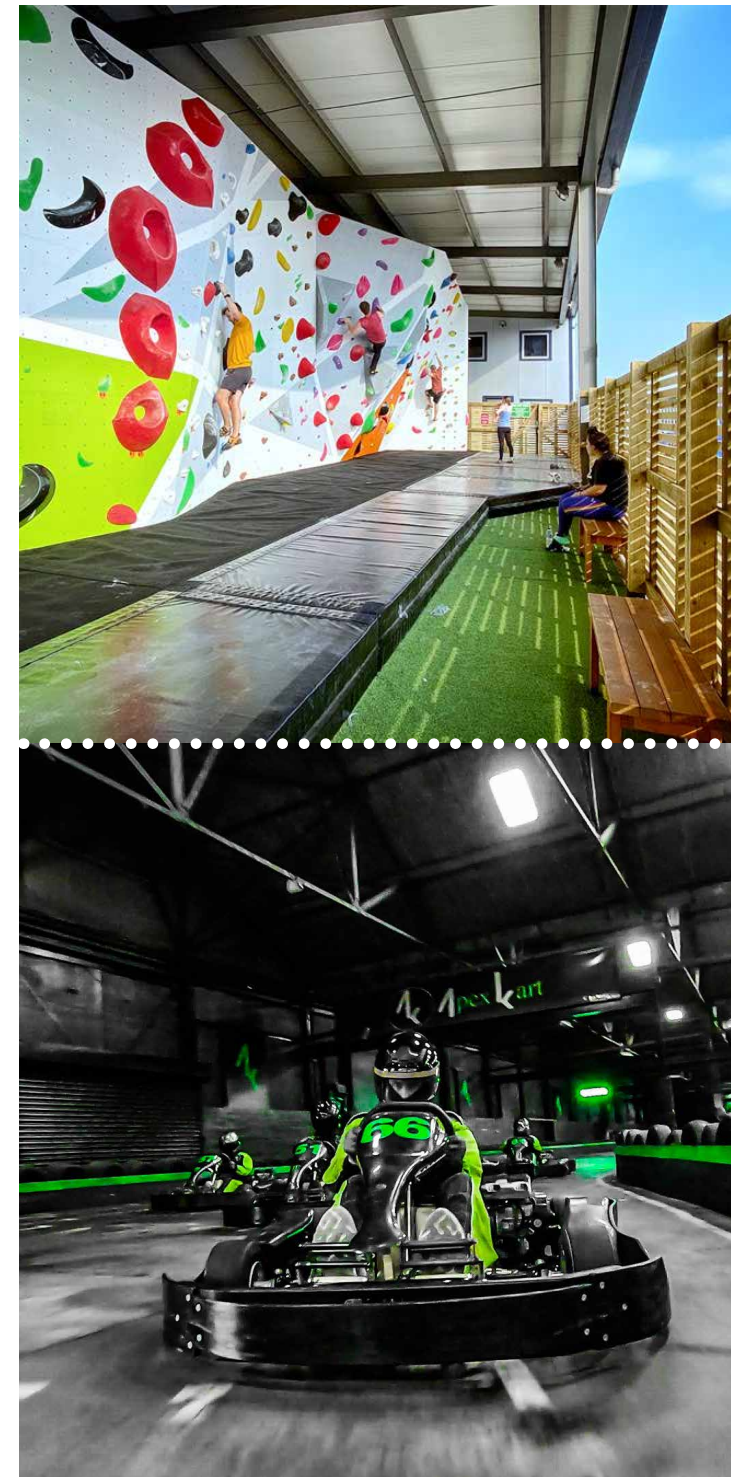

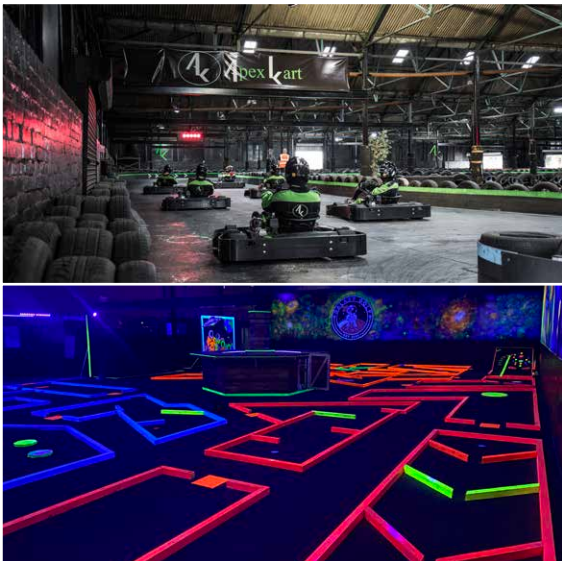

Many national trails also begin or end their journey within the county, meaning if you feel the urge to expand your horizons further, you can do so with the foundation that Flintshire provides.

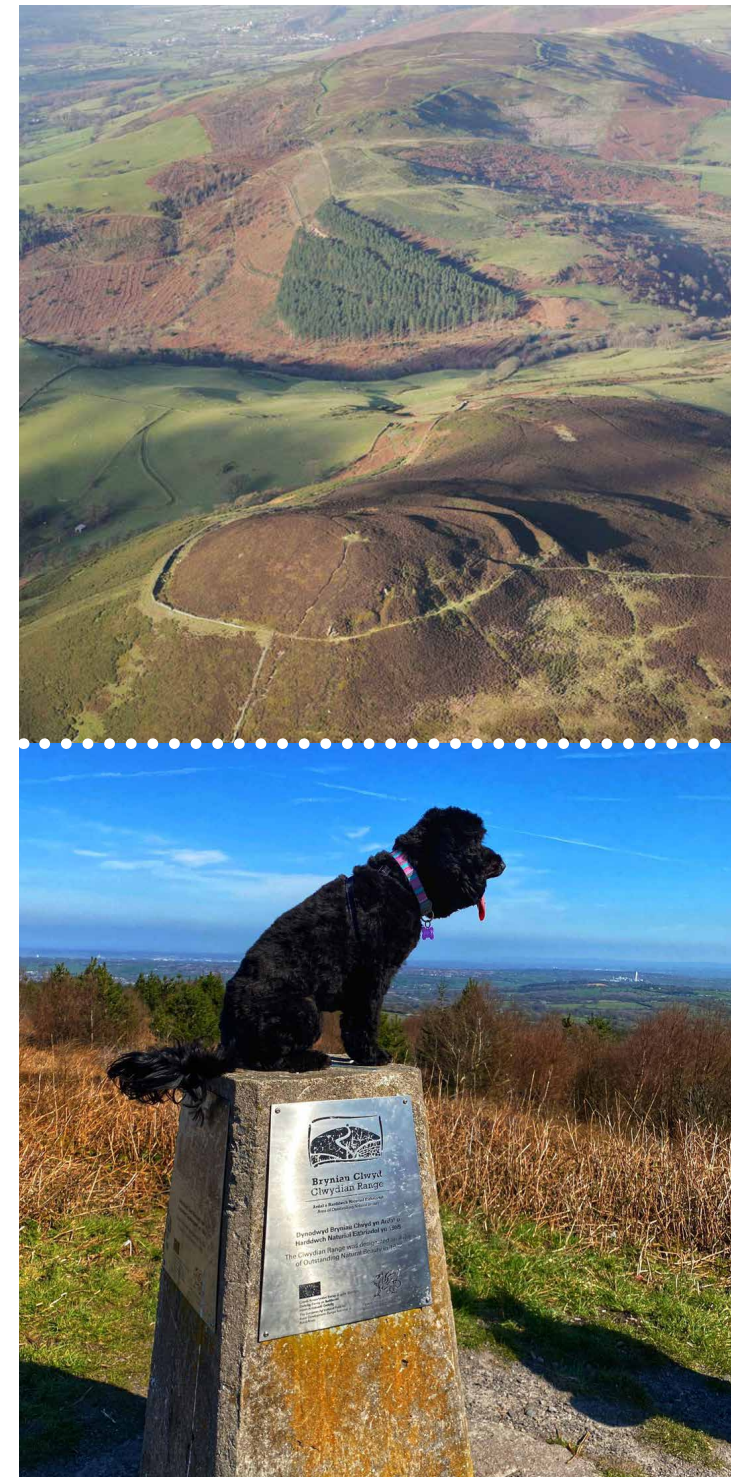

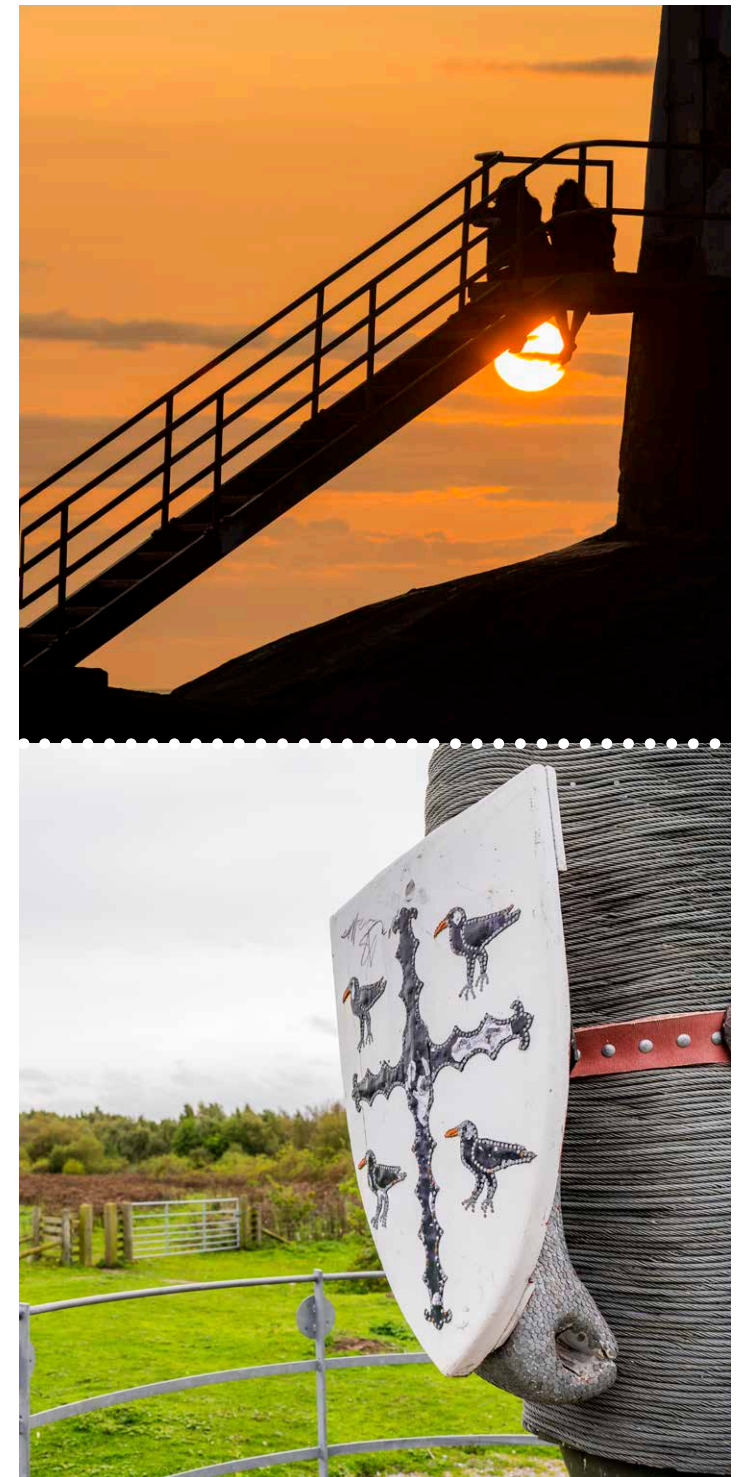

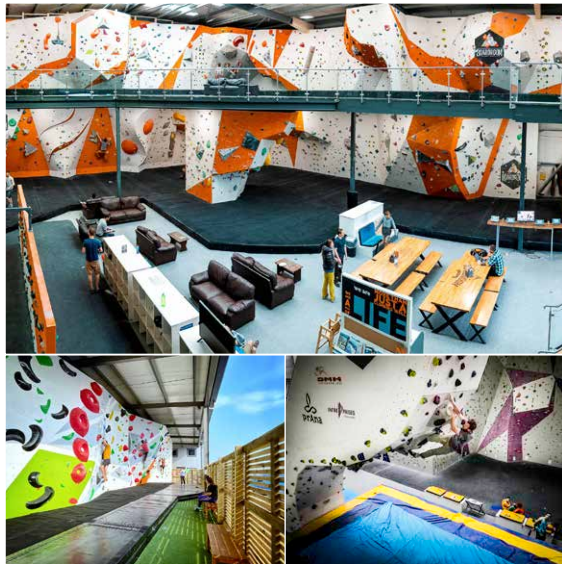
